Get connected at St. Paul's!

What is a sermon series?

What is a connection group?

St. Paul's connection groups will include hospitality, connection, and discussion related to the scripture, teaching and application of Sunday morning sermons.

When and where are the groups?

The Luke Sermon Series connection groups will meet between end-January to end-March with hosts and facilitators who have been established by the pastors and director of discipleship.
